1.3.1 Institution integrates crosscutting issues relevant to Professional Ethics, Gender, Human Values, Environment and Sustainability into the Curriculum

Our institution develops human values, professional ethics, environmental preservation, gender equality, and responsibility in addition to fostering professional ideals. These efforts are made possible by the curriculum and co-curricular activities offered to students.

The institution guarantees that Continuous Internal Evaluation and evaluation adhere to standardised and transparent procedures, allowing students to attain the minimum required number of Credits for promotion to the subsequent semester/year.

The "Human Values and Professional Ethics" course, offered in the third year, second semester of the Pharmacy degree at JNTUH, Hyderabad, enhances the curriculum by enabling students to internalise ethical conduct in both their personal and professional lives.

The students enrolled in our college actively coordinate and participate in health camps, offering their voluntary assistance to the general public on matters pertaining to health.
